Kakivak's Inuit Childcare Program offers financial support to licensed Qikiqtani Childcare Centres. This support is aimed at covering basic operational and maintenance costs for centres that offer childcare services to eligible Inuit parents. These parents must be either working, studying, or participating in traditional economies.

This declaration form allows the Childcare Centre to collect the necessary information to allow them to apply for and meet the requirements for financial support from Kakivak Association.

Eligibility

Childcare Centres are eligible for financial support for basic operations and maintenance if the children are of Qikiqtani Inuit residents who are working, studying or participating in traditional economies. Traditional economies may include hunting, fishing, carving, and other arts and crafts that contribute to the economic welfare of the family.

The Inuk Parent who is working, studying or participating in the traditional economy must register with the Childcare Centre and sign the declaration form.

The Childcare Centre will use the information you provide on this form to apply for financial support from Kakivak Association.
