

The Small Tools Grant is intended for applicants who wish to make an income or additional income by selling handmade products that involve carving, sewing, jewellery, or traditional tools.

The small tools grant must not exceed the following amounts:

- \$1,500 for carving tools (Once every 3 years)
- \$2,500 for sewing machine (Once every 5 years)
 plus:
- \$500 for materials (Once every 3 years)

The applicant must contribute a minimum of 10% of the total of purchases or funding request.

This grant applies to Inuit enrolled to the Qikiqtani Region with NTI. Applicants from other regions who have lived in Qikiqtani region are also eligible by providing proof of residency of 6 months or more in the Qikiqtani Region.
